



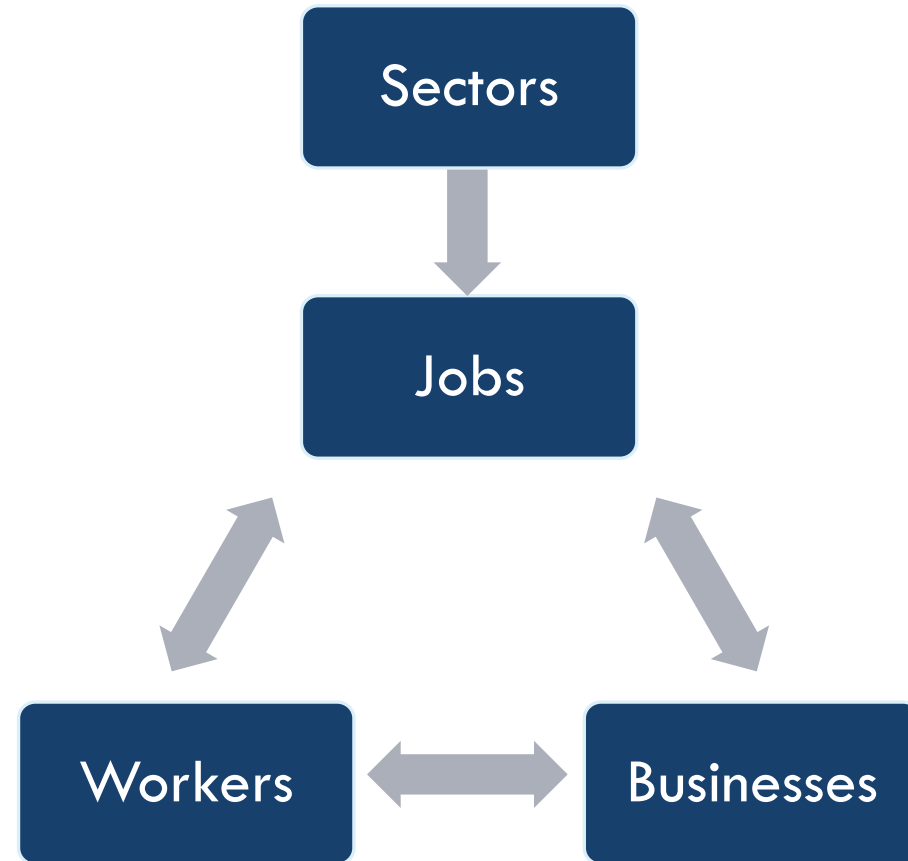

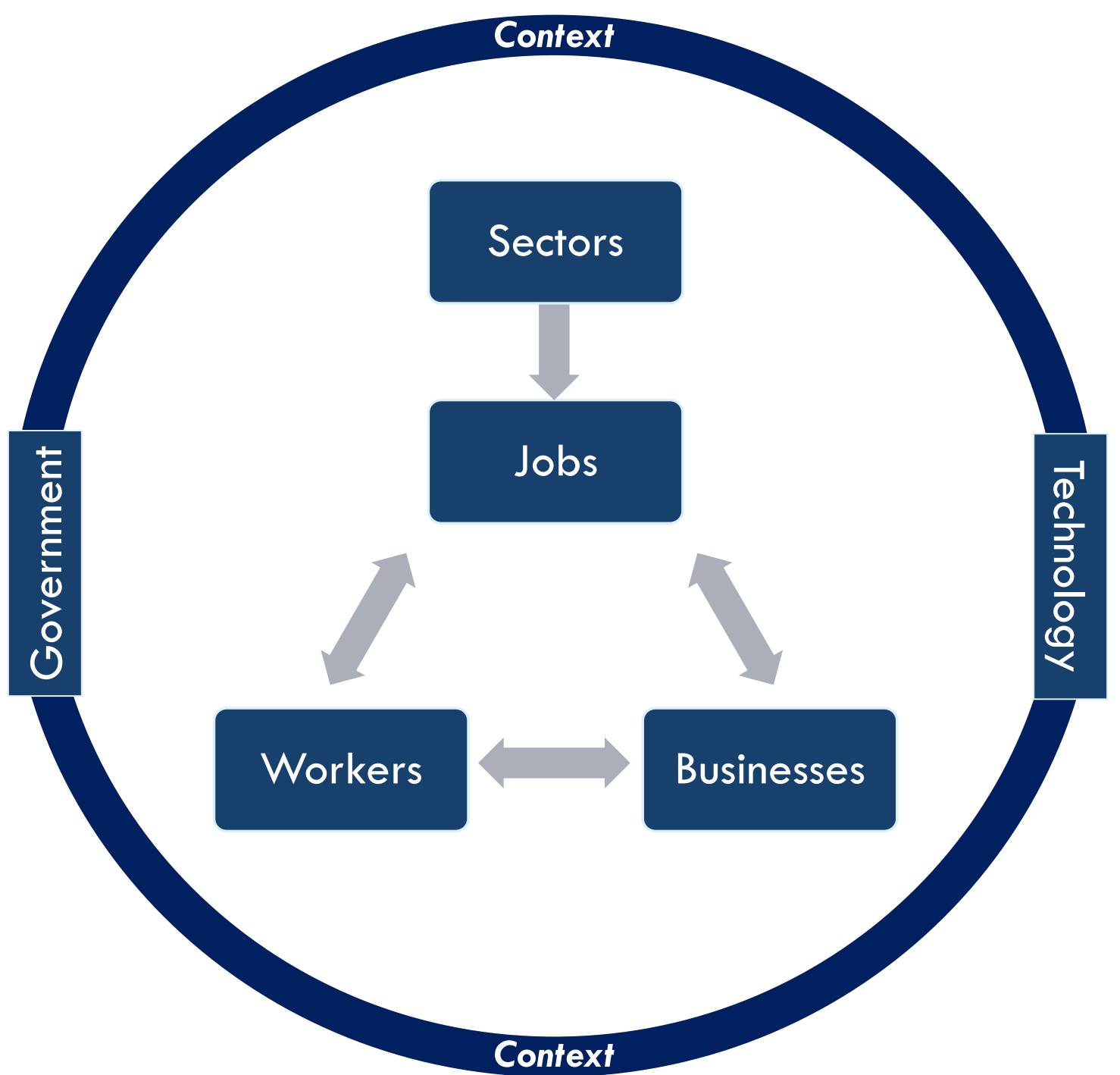

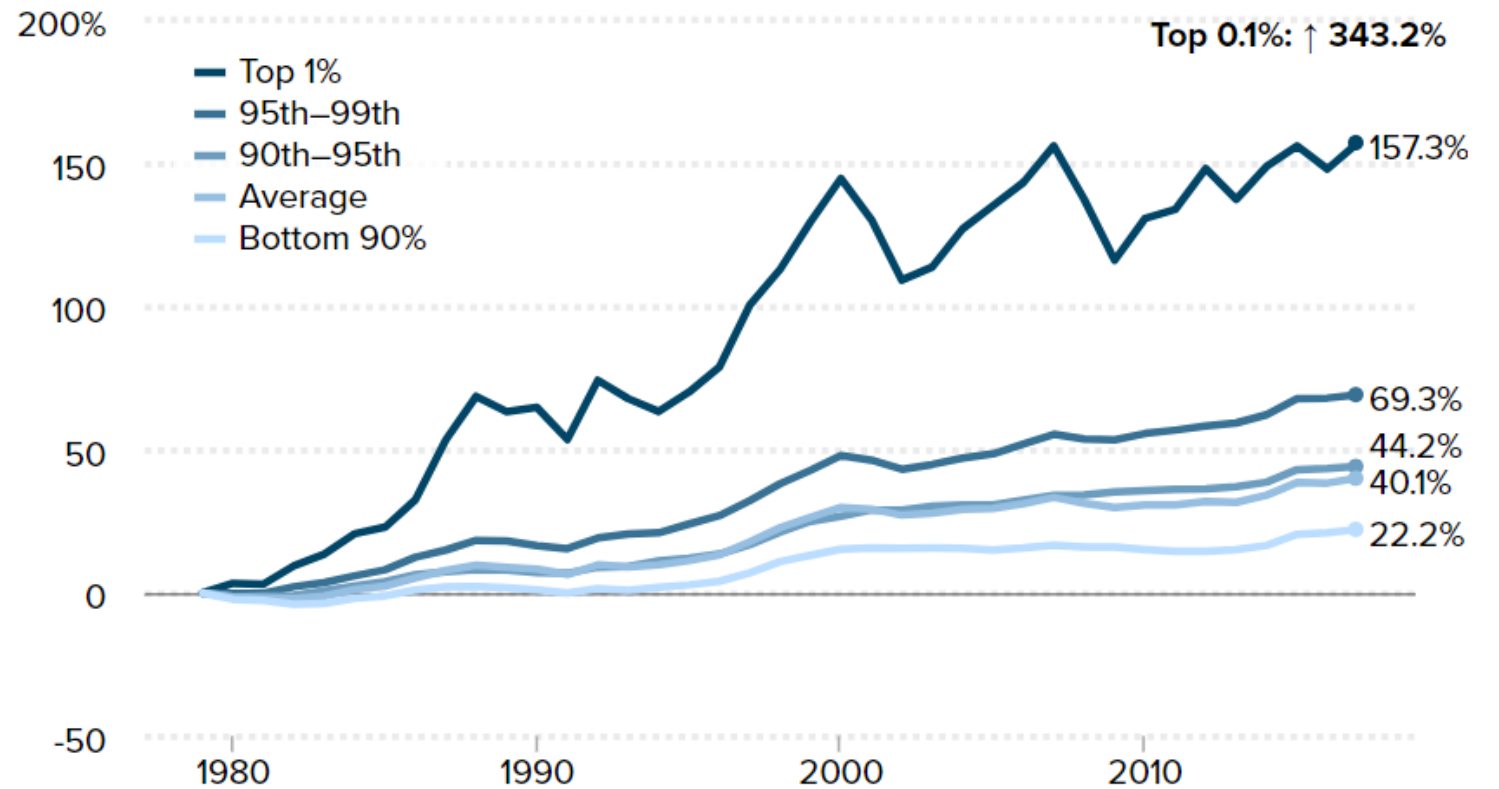

NEW ECONOMY LABOR MARKET I

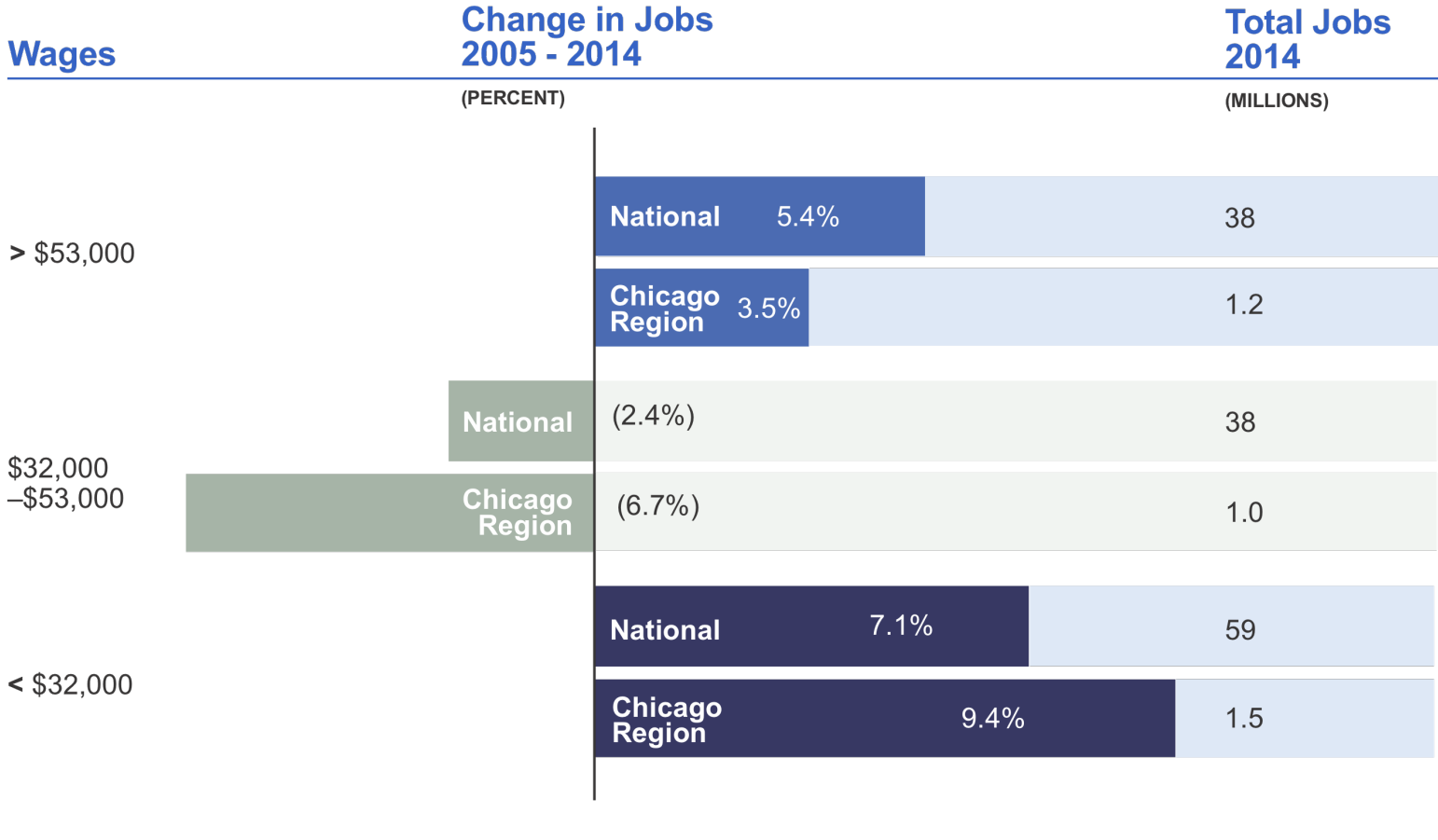
Cumulative percent change in real annual wages, by wage group, 1979-2017

Job Growth in the Chicago Region

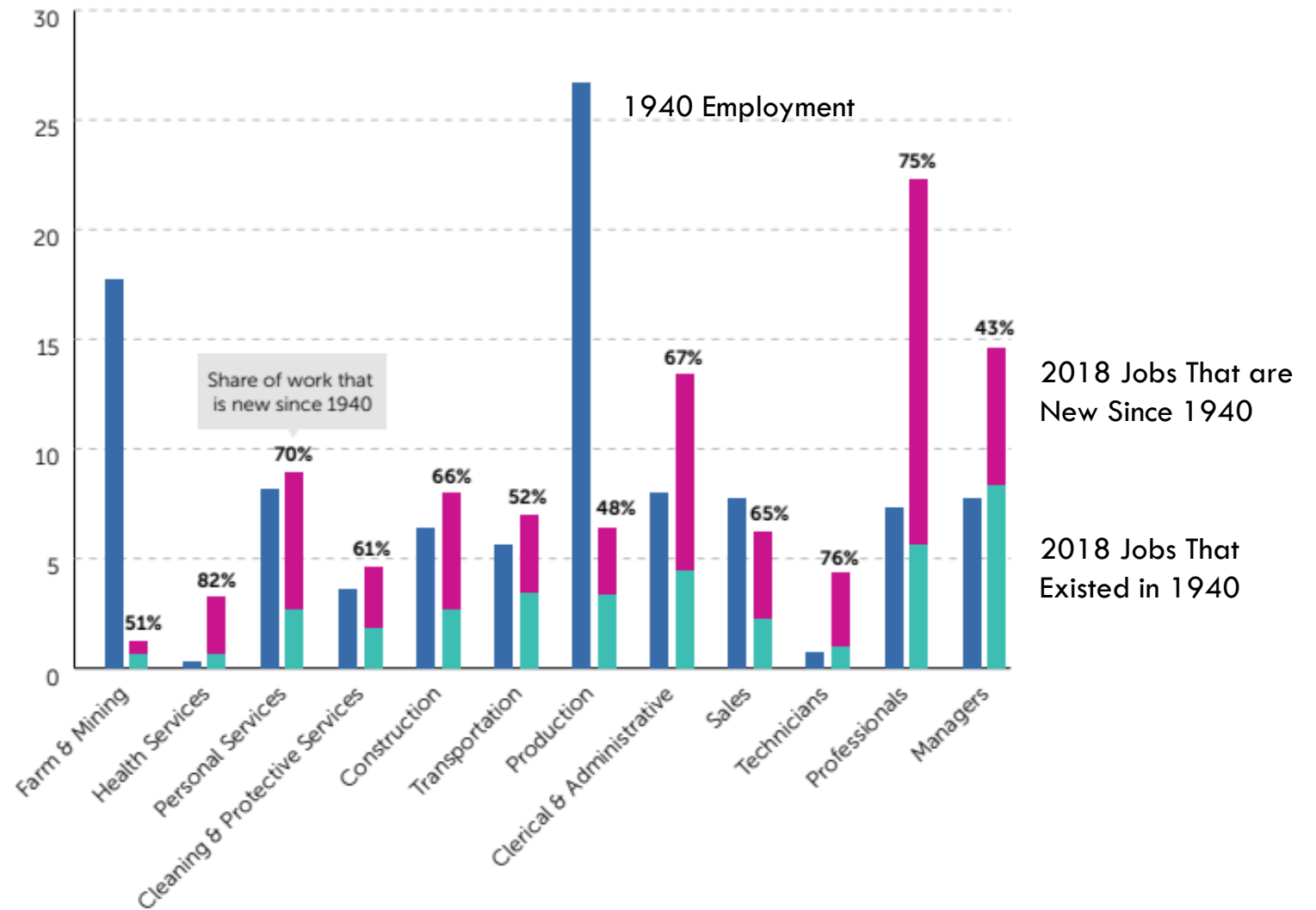

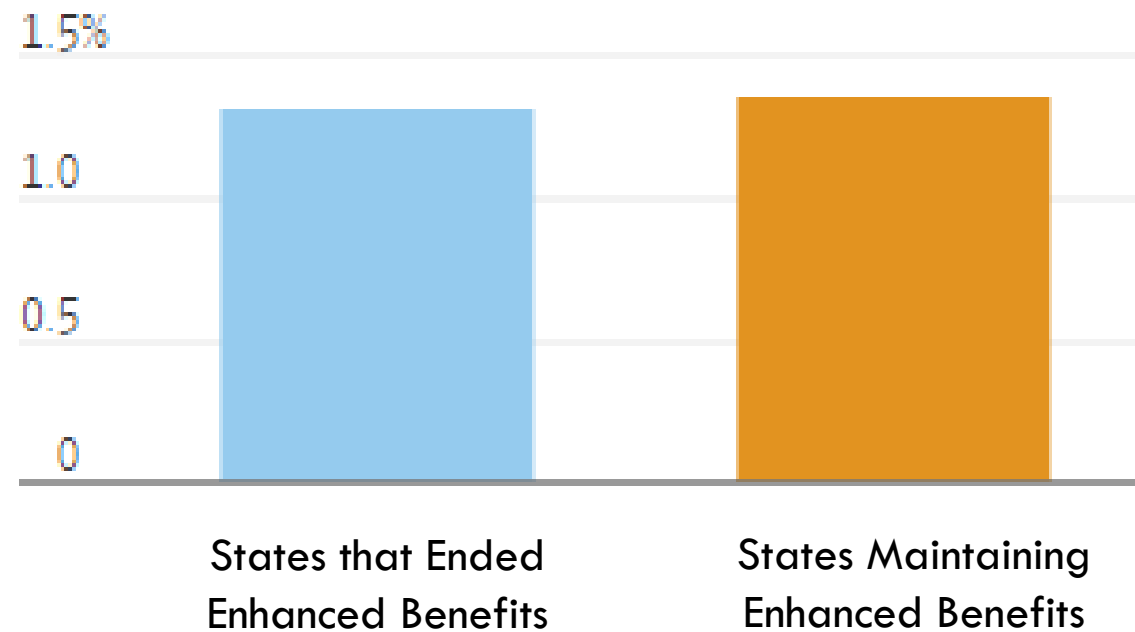
Employment Share

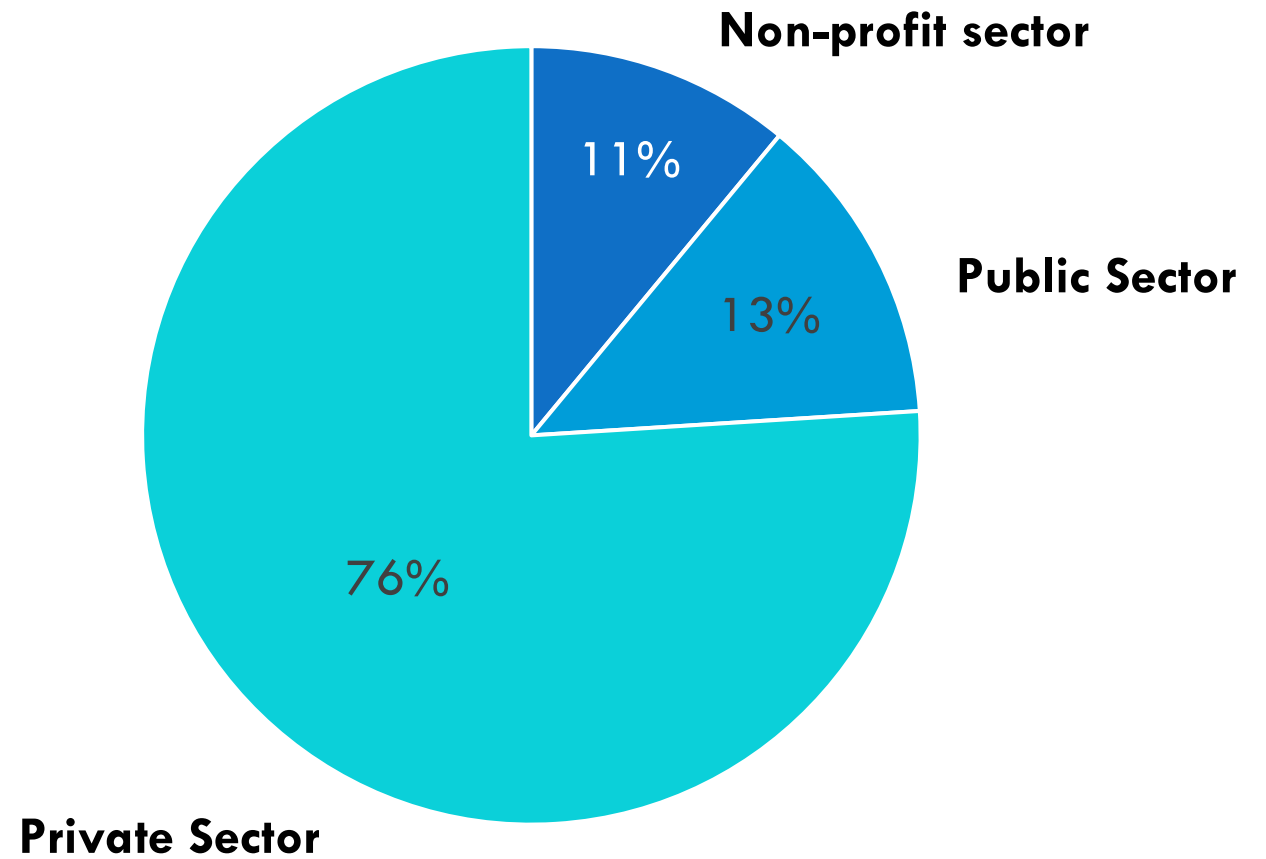
