Federal Grant Support Program

Overview: The Federal Grant Support Program makes cost-share support

available to encourage the submission of more Illinois-based

proposals to competitive federal opportunities.

Process: If selected, letter of funding commitment provided. Grant

agreement and state funds contingent on receiving federal award.

Deadline: Formal DCEO application required at least 3-weeks prior to

associated federal application submission. Late submissions will

not be accepted.

Primary Requirements:

- 1:1 match of the applicant's cash contribution towards the project.
- Cannot exceed the federal award amount.
- If Illinois-based, at least 51% of project activities must occur in Illinois.
- If not Illinois-based, at least 90% of project activities must occur in Illinois.
- Projects must align with the state's economic development goals and not have a primary purpose of transportation, parks, social services or housing.

Award Size: Up to \$2,000,000
