The goal of the Illinois Digital Equity Capacity Grant (IDEC) grant program is to ensure that all people and communities across Illinois have the skills, technology, and capacity needed to reap the full benefits of our digital economy and thrive. Digital equity is a way of prioritizing access and opportunities for groups that have the greatest need and who are most impacted by digital inequities.

How Can the IDEC Grant **Impact You?**

- The IDEC Grant Program will allow eligible organizations to apply for funding to support digital equity initiatives for vulnerable community members.
- IDEC awards between \$30,000 and \$300,000 annually for a three year term.
- · Projects must serve one or more of the eight Covered Populations specified by the National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA).
