IDEC Toolkit: General Grant Glossary

Capacity

The ability to implement projects and create change. Can include aspects like time available, staff levels, knowledge and training, past experience, funding levels, etc.

Evaluation

Collection of relevant data and measurement of success.

Grantee

The organization that is awarded grant funds.

Inputs

Resources put into a project to make it work, ex. Funds, staff time, etc. Ex. Fuel for a car, air for the tires, time for the driver to drive the car.

Merit Review

The process by which the IDEC grant applications are evaluated or graded.

Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO)

Announcement of a grant opportunity, including all the project and eligibility requirements.

Outcomes

Measurable changes brought about by the project.

Ex. By driving 12 miles, the driver was able to visit the park and picnic with friends.

Outputs

Activities implemented, services rendered, work done as a part of the project. Ex. The driver used the fuel and air and time to drive the car 12 miles

Qualitative Data

Data that is interpretation-based, descriptive, narrative in nature.

Quantitative Data

Data that can be precisely measured and expressed in numbers and percentages, objective, "Hard Data".
