# **DCEO's Federal Grant Support Program**

(DCEO)'s Federal Grant Match Program will make \$15 million available to Illinois-based businesses and organizations seeking competitive federal grants.

# **Loan Programs**

# <u>Advantage Illinois – State Small Business Credit Initiative (SSBCI) 2.0</u>

As the Advantage Illinois program supports small businesses by enhancing access to financial capital, the programs make eligibility as flexible as possible, maximizing the impact on Illinois economy and especially encouraging loans to <a href="Socially and Economically Disadvantaged Individuals">Socially and Economically Disadvantaged Individuals</a> (SEDI) and Very Small Businesses (VSB), or businesses with fewer than 10 employees.

- The Advantage Illinois Participation Loan Program (PLP) helps Illinois businesses get term loan financing at lower rates by purchasing a portion of the loan and lowering risk for lenders.
- The **Advantage Illinois Loan Guarantee Program (LGP)** will provide a guarantee of partial repayment to the lender if a loan goes into default.

As the <u>Advantage Illinois Participation Loan Program (PLP)</u> helps Illinois businesses get term loan financing at lower rates, the state purchases a portion of the loan, which lowers the risk for the lenders. Advantage Illinois fills the gaps that prevent businesses from obtaining financing due to:

- · collateral and/or equity shortfalls
- · lack of historical cash flow
- low credit scores
- negative net worth

Advantage Illinois PLP offers a program for **Socially and Economically Disadvantaged Individual(s) (SEDI)** which helps businesses owned/ controlled by individuals with diminished credit. SEDI supports the following business owners and entrepreneurs:

- · membership of a group subjected to racial/ ethnic prejudice or cultural bias
- · gender
- · veteran status
- · limited English proficiency
- · long-term residence in an isolated environment from mainstream American society
- · member of a federally or state-recognized Indian Tribe
- · long-term residence in a rural community
- · residence in a community undergoing economic transitions
- membership of another "underserved community" (Executive Order 13985)

#### Socially and Economically Disadvantaged Individual(s) (SEDI) loan program details

Maximum participation is the lesser of:

- 50% of the project (all sources of funding)
- · 50% of the loan
- · \$2 million

#### Maximum term is 7 years

- · Rate fixed at 2%
- · Job creation and/or Retention: With each \$65,000 participated, one full-time job should be created or retained in the next 2 years

# **INVENT Venture Capital Program (VCP) (New Program)**

The Innovation Venture Fund (INVENT) will operate as a direct equity investment program, investing in earlyand late-stage businesses with a focus on underserved start-ups facing systemic barriers and key industries such as agriculture, energy, information technology, life sciences, manufacturing, quantum information sciences and technology, and transportation.

# **Climate Bank Finance Participation Loan Program (New Program)**

This new program will be overseen by DCEO and administered by the Illinois Finance Authority (IFA), which will partner with local lenders to issue the loans. As Illinois has officially designated "Climate Bank", IFA will be exclusively focusing on providing its SSBCI-supported financing for the start-up and/or expansion of ventures directly involving environmentally-supportive, "green" businesses, including those that address the adverse impacts of climate change.

#### **Incentives and Tax Assistance**

Illinois offers a competitive range of incentives for locating and expanding your business, including tax credits such as the Illinois Angel Investment Tax Credit Program which encourages investment in innovative, early-stage companies to help obtain the working capital needed to further the growth of their company in Illinois and exemptions that encourage business growth and job creation. Additional grant programs and access to loans can assist your business with working capital, machinery and equipment, land acquisition, building construction and public infrastructure improvements. And for those looking to invest in Illinois companies, early-stage investment incentives are also available.

#### **Incentives and Tax Assistance**

As the State of Illinois greatly expanded business incentives to attract and retain job creators looking to locate or expand their business in Illinois. Those new changes in 2023 include:

- \$400 Million Closing Fund: Discretionary cash assistance available for major job creators with significant investments through the Invest in Illinois Fund.
- Expanding and improving Illinois' premier incentive programs, including:

  - Reimagining Energy and Vehicles (REV Illinois)
     Economic Development for a Growing Economy (EDGE)
     Manufacturing Illinois Chips for Real Opportunity (MICRO)
  - High Impact Businesses (HIB) Enterprise Zone Expansion

## About the Illinois Science & Technology Coalition (ISTC)

The Illinois Science & Technology Coalition (ISTC) is a member-driven, 501(c)(6) non-profit, nonpartisan organization that cultivates technology-based economic development throughout Illinois. Our work includes innovation programming, research/data, policy, and advocacy at a state and federal level.

The Illinois Science & Technology Institute (ISTI), our 501(c)(3)-affiliate, focuses on Science, Technology, Education and Mathematics (STEM) education, connecting companies with classrooms to better prepare the next generation of problem solvers.

## ISTC's Programs

- ABOUT ISTC: Authorized by state statute in 1989 as Illinois' technology adviser, the Illinois Science & Technology Coalition (ISTC) serves as a
  convener, catalyst, and champion for Illinois' research, science, and technology communities. By providing our members and partners with a shared
  voice, ISTC delivers measurable economic impact and positions Illinois as a national innovation leader. Our mission is to measure, connect, and
  enrich the Illinois innovation economy.
- Our work consists of Data Research and Impact Reporting through our <u>Illinois Innovation Index Series</u>, <u>Policy and Advocacy work</u> at a state and federal level and Innovation Programming, listed below:
- **VENTURE ENGINE®:** Venture Engine is an online platform, launched by ISTC in 2021, complemented by virtual and in-person programming that connects Illinois' most promising startups to the state's most innovative corporations. **Click here** to access it. Corporate partners can:
  - scout innovative startups in industries and technology areas that are critical to their business
  - explore a curated database of engagement-ready startups scouted on an ongoing basis
  - connect with startups that can help grow innovation within their company
- VENTURE ENGINE®'S EXECUTIVE FOUNDER SERIES: GET (Gender Equality in Tech) Cities and their Tech Equity Working Group (TEWG) awarded The Illinois Science & Technology Coalition a grant to launch the Executive Founder Series, which is focused on improving gender diversity in seed and series stage founders by facilitating corporate and venture capital connections between startup founders.
  - The program hosts six startup founders in a series of networking opportunities that offer introductions to seasoned subject matter experts across Chicago's innovation ecosystem, including civic/nonprofit, corporate, and venture capital leaders. Link here. The program also provides Venture Engine's entire network of founders complimentary access to special events including galas, award ceremonies, workshops, and networking events that are typically cost-prohibitive, but beneficial to business development.

## ISTC's Programs

- **VENTURE ENGINE®'S INDUSTRY SERIES:** ISTC hosts a suite of programs dedicated to advancing the work of Venture Engine founders through curated opportunities for education, business development, and networking.
  - Lunch and Learns: ISTC's Lunch and Learns provide insights on best practices for back-of-office strategies including HR, legal considerations (i.e. intellectual property, branding, etc.), business development, and industry trends. The workshops are free, virtual, and feature subject-matter experts to support startups in each growth stage.
  - **Workshops:** ISTC hosts in-person workshops on a quarterly basis, open to the public, and centered around specific industry topics. These workshops invite expert panelists to share valuable insights and knowledge within their respective fields. Some are designed to position founders as the specialist, offering exposure and a platform for their product or service, and others are designed as learning experiences for founders to learn from seasoned professionals.
  - **Pitch Showcases and Networking Dinners:** ISTC's quarterly Pitch Showcases feature five to seven Venture Engine startups and their elevator pitch. These presentations provide startups with a platform to showcase their product or service to an audience of potential partners and/or mentors. ISTC curates an audience of 20-30 industry experts that are specifically aligned with each founders' goals to support meaningful feedback and networking.
    - Following the Pitch Showcases, ISTC hosts private networking dinners. These dinners invite the participating startups and select audience members to continue conversations over dinner and are designed to foster deeper engagement between the founders and leaders in their industry.

## ISTC's STEM Education Programing

Through our 501(c)(3) Educational Institute, we pave the way for the next generation of innovators by connecting students to companies and developing a stronger, more inclusive talent pipeline in Illinois. Through our programs—STEM Challenges, Mentor Matching Engine, The 6 x 3 Project, and Teacher Externships—we've paired thousands of students and teachers from across the state with mentors from around the world. **If startups** are looking for way to impact their communities, we have the following programs for them to participate.

- <u>STEM Challenges</u> are real-world projects that create opportunities for high school students to work alongside STEM professionals as mentors. Students and mentors from STEM Challenge industry partners collaborate over the course of six months to explore, create, and build innovative solutions.
- <u>The Mentor Matching Engine (MME)</u> is an invitation-based web platform that connects Illinois high school students and their teachers to STEM professionals who serve as online mentors. By connecting mentors and students electronically, MME is able to offer high-quality mentoring experiences and overcome geographic barriers.
- 6 weeks, 3 STEM opportunities, one impactful program. The 6×3 project recognizes that STEM does not exist in a silo, and takes an interdisciplinary approach, combining 3 pillars of STEM. Whether that be math, design thinking, or marketing skills, students will leave the 6×3 project with a robust, real world end product and skills needed to be successful in the future workforce.
- <u>Teacher Externships</u> are a critical link between the context of industry and the content of a classroom. Teachers get the opportunity to experience and use the latest real-world applications of STEM disciplines to better inform their teaching practices and prepare students to enter the STEM talent pipeline after high school, creating lasting partnerships between workplaces and local schools.

The Polsky Center advances all University of Chicago entrepreneurship and research commercialization innovation activities through the creation of new ventures and partnerships. The Polsky Center also supports local South and West Side community entrepreneurs and small business owners as well as University of Chicago alumni around the globe.

## Polsky Exchange Membership

Operated by the Polsky Center for Entrepreneurship and Innovation, the Polsky Exchange is a 34,000-square-foot startup incubator featuring work and meeting spaces, a Fabrication Lab for prototyping physical products, and a full calendar of programming and workshops designed to help entrepreneurs launch and grow their ventures. Part of UChicago's commitment to supporting economic development in the community, the Polsky Exchange has two buildings on Hyde Park's vibrant 53rd Street corridor – Exchange North at 1452 E. 53rd St. and Exchange South at 1463 E. 53rd St.

Membership is open to business owners and innovators in the community as well as UChicago students, faculty, and staff actively working on entrepreneurial ventures or involved in Polsky Center programs.

#### As a member of the Polsky Exchange, the following resources are available:

- Workspace: Access to the workspace in Polsky Exchange North Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. This includes access to the conference rooms for hosting business meetings and conference calls, and access to the Tech Bar.
- Fab Lab: Opportunity to sign up for time and equipment authorizations at the Fab Lab maker space, located in Polsky Exchange South. Fab Lab staff are also available to offer expert design, prototyping, and product development guidance.
- Programs and Workshops: Invitations to weekly workshops on innovation and entrepreneurship topics, and assistance in applying to the Polsky Center's free, cohort-based programs for community entrepreneurs such as the Small Business Growth Program and Small Business Financial Fundamentals.
- Mentorship: The Polsky Center has 100+ mentors who are ready to meet with you virtually or in person and assist you in navigating your business challenges and to plan for growth and scale.
