If your facility does qualify under the criteria listed in the enclosed form you must submit the attached Initial Notification Report to the USEPA and the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by May 5, 2010.

On January 5, 2010 the USEPA adopted new requirements for prepared feeds manufacturing facilities. This new rule includes management practices to minimize or eliminate possible emissions and recordkeeping and reporting requirements.
