## Subpart M Federal Register Summary

Topic: National Perchloroethylene Air Emission Standards for Dry Cleaning Facilities

Agency: Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)

Action: Final rule; withdrawal; revision.

This entry of the Federal Register details the EPA’s action on July 11, 2008 of revising a previous action taken on July 27, 2006. This revision was a response to comments the EPA received on the previous ruling. The revisions that were implemented affirm that “the requirement to eliminate perc emissions from dry cleaning systems installed after December 21, 2005, “applies to any newly installed dry cleaning system that is located in a building with a residence, regardless of whether the dry cleaning system is a newly fabricated system or one that is relocated from another facility””.
