## **ZZZZ (4Z) Code of Federal Regulations Summary**

Topic: Stationary Reciprocating Internal Combustion Engines

Agency: Environmental Protection Agency

This entry of the CFR establishes emission standards for stationary reciprocating internal combustion engines (RICE) located at major and area sources of hazardous air pollutant emissions (HAP) emissions. Owners and operators must comply with varying emissions standards depending on if their source is a stationary RICE with a site rating of more than 500 brake HP, a new or reconstructed 4SLB stationary RICE with a site rating of greater than or equal to 250 brake HP and less than or equal to 500 brake HP, an existing stationary RICE with a site rating of equal to or less than 500 brake HP, or an existing stationary RICE located at an area source.

Owners and operators must operate and maintain any affected source, including associated air pollution control equipment and monitoring equipment, in a manner consistent with safety and good air pollution control practices for minimizing emissions. Monitoring must be done continuously at all times that the stationary RICE is operating.
