#### TRADE AND INVESTMENT STATISTICS

#### Exports are a Vital Part of Illinois' Economy<sup>A</sup>

- Preliminary Illinois exports totaled over \$78.67 billion in 2022. The preliminary agricultural adjusted figure for 2022 is \$82.69 billion; both All Time Highs.<sup>c</sup>
- Since 2009, Illinois exports have increased by \$37.05 billion, or 89.0%
- Illinois is the largest exporting state in the Midwest and the 5th largest in the nation, using agricultural adjusted figures provided by Census Bureau/USDA cash receipts.<sup>c</sup>
- 19 out of top 20 export industries increased since 2021
- 19 out of top 20 export industries increased since 2009
- Top 10 Illinois export industries have seen gains since 2009
- 9 of the top 10 Illinois export partner countries have seen gains since 2009
- Export activities support over 800K jobs in Illinois.<sup>B</sup>

#### **Total Trade between Illinois and Ireland in 2022**

- Illinois exports to Ireland totaled \$1.03 billion in 2022, a 655.3% increase since 2009. Ireland is Illinois' 15th largest export market
- Illinois ranks 5th among the 50 U.S. states in exports to Ireland
- Illinois imports from Ireland totaled \$3.03 billion in 2022, a 437.5% increase since 2009. Ireland is Illinois' 14th largest import market
- Illinois ranks 7th among the 50 U.S. states in imports from Ireland
